



Logging AATD Simulator Time

An AATD can be used to log:

Experience requirements for cross country, night, solo, takeoffs and landings and 3 hours in preceding 2 months must be completed in the airplane, not in a simulator.

Part 61

- ✈ Up to 2.5 hours towards private pilot time requirements
- ✈ Up to 20 hours towards instrument training time requirements
- ✈ Up to 50 hours towards commercial pilot time requirements
- ✈ Up to 25 hours towards Airline Transport Pilot time requirements

Part 141

- ✈ Up to 15% towards private pilot time requirements
- ✈ Up to 40% towards instrument time requirements
- ✈ Up to 20% towards commercial time requirements
- ✈ Up to 25% towards Airline Transport Pilot (ATP) time requirements
- ✈ Up to 5% towards Flight Instructor time requirements
- ✈ Up to 5% towards Flight Instructor – Instrument time requirements
